



The City of Carmel Utilities is proud to offer its customers the Citizens Utility Academy program. This program provides insight on the operations of the water, wastewater, household hazardous waste and trash & recycling services.

The Utility Citizens Academy is a 6-week program meeting weekly for 1.5 to 2 hours in the morning. Classes are taught by various members of the Utility Department and Republic Services who provide instruction and information regarding their particular area of profession allowing citizens the opportunity for an in-depth look on how the department operates. Behind the scenes tours of Utility and recycling facilities are a key part of the program.

Applicants must be at least 18 years old and a resident of Carmel. Class size is limited to 12 people and applications will be reviewed on a first come first served basis.
